I am ashamed to admit it, but I hesitated. He held no papers in need of stapling. Behind the wall of my office and "wall" of my privilege, I held a stapler. In that momentary hesitation, Christ came to teach me, again, the nature of discipleship. By God's grace, I went out and gave him the stapler. He bent down and began to staple his torn pants leg from his ankle to his knee. He had only wanted to shield himself from the bitter cold – and I had almost refused to serve in even that simple way.
