Summer Schedule June 17-September 3: Parishioners Provide Input

On Sunday June 3, Fr. Ron asked both the 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. congregations about what they would like to do for summer services prior to a liturgy committee meeting on June 6. There was unanimous support at the 8:00 a.m. among the 25 present to keep both the 8 & 10 during the summer. The congregation at the 10 of 60+ folks were divided between one combined service at 9 and keeping the 8 & 10. After long debate by the liturgy committee we are going to be trying on something this summer that tries to integrate all voices. When Fr. Ron is away on June 17, July 15 & 22 there will be one combined service with a guest priest at 9. Other Sundays we are trying on an 8 and 9:00 a.m. service rather than a 10 a.m. The primary logic for moving from 10 to 9 is that by 10 a.m. the church gets rather hot and uncomfortable. So by going from the 8 right into the 9 folks will be able to get out before the heat of the day really sets in. Again, this is a try-on to see if it makes sense. We will evaluate the experience in the fall as to its success or failure.
